ATTENDANCE AND LATES

We have a **low** attendance rate and **high** 'late' issue which we need to **significantly** improve. We will work with you to help and support as much as we can but ultimately it is the **parent/carers responsibility** to ensure that the children are in school and on time.

As a result, we will have targeted meetings with parents to help set up support plans and then monitor the improvement. Unfortunately, if things are not heading in the right direction then it will likely become a **legal matter and prosecution** could be the end result. So, we feel it is vitally important that we initially work together to avoid this situation becoming a legal matter. Here are some new changes to help improve the whole school attendance: -

Lates:

You need to be on the playground for 8:45 am. If the classroom outer doors are closed and you have to come through the office to drop off, then this is classed as a late. When you come through the office, instead of talking to the office team, you will be given a clipboard and pen to fill out a late form for us to file and keep. This form will take approximately 10 minutes to fill in and will ask you a series of questions. If you are later than 9:20 then this is recorded as an **unauthorised absence**. Parents always need to accompany their child/dren if they are late and fill out the form for them.

Absence:

If your child is absent we will be monitoring this very closely using our new **Arbor** system. If you are close to the warning zone we will inform you. If you cross into the absence zone then we will be calling you in to an attendance support meeting and potentially creating an attendance support plan/agreement. We will monitor this carefully and hopefully avoid heading towards prosecution. By engaging with us and working with us we hope to see a vast improvement in the attendance rate.

It is your responsibility to **inform** the School by 9.15am if your child(ren) are absent, either by phoning the school office
