### Home Learning

This includes TT RockStars (times tables facts) and Spelling Shed (spellings). We will send reminders in due course, but many children already know their log-ins. Just 10 minutes a day on each of these will really help their learning 'stick' more easily. Reading regularly will also make a HUGE difference! Your child will be given their own reading bookmark which can be ticked daily to gain logs. We will be launching our new home reading bookmarks next week; children will be aiming to gain shark badges and a trophy. Bookmarks will be checked and recorded on a Friday. We will also send home a homework choice board for your children to complete over this half term. Our first topic is 'Harsh Environments'.



### Seesaw

We continue to use Seesaw to communicate with you and to share children's learning. Please can we ask that you download the app so you can view important messages and your children's work. Your child will have a copy of the log in details but if you need any support with this, please let your child's teacher know so we can get you logged in **as soon as possible**.
