Dear Parents/Carers

During this term, Years 5 and 6 will be visited by Shannon Reddin who is a trained relationship, sexual health practitioner. She will be delivering specific National Curriculum objectives, which are age related, covering the following:

Year 6

- To know about how the body changes as they approach puberty.
- Sexual thoughts and feelings (including nocturnal emissions).
- To know how babies are made
- To recognise and know about the male and female reproduction organs and to use key words linked to reproduction.
- To know the process involved in fertilisation/ artificial fertilisation.
- To know what needs to be considered before a person decide to have a baby.
- To understand the role of infection and conception and the role contraception plays and where to get help and advice.

We have used the statutory RSHE curriculum (2014) and the PSHE association guidance to inform our professional approach. Each year group will be taught appropriate to their age and developmental stage. At no point will a child be taught something that is inappropriate; and if a question from a child arises and the adult feels it would be inappropriate to answer, (for example, because of its mature or explicit nature), this information will be shared with you by your child's class teacher. The question will not be answered to the child or class if it is outside the remit of that year group's programme.
