#### **Dear Parents & Carers**

As previously mentioned, I am writing to remind you that school prices will increase effective from Monday 5th June, and will cost £3.00 per day. This is payable in advance using your child's SCOPay account and preferably on the Monday before meals are taken during that week. SCOPay account details are available from the school office by calling the above phone number or by request using our adminoffice@sharpscopse.hants.sch.uk mailbox; please put your child's name in the subject heading.

If your child is absent during this time, the meal will be credited and carried forward until their return to school. £15.00 per week should be paid if they have a school lunch every day. Please follow this link https://www.hants.gov.uk/educationandlearning/hc3s/education-catering/menu-primary for the current school meal menu. This will change when we return to school after the autumn half term break; more details will be made available once we receive notification from the school caterer's and sent to you in advance.

The services provided by school are no different to those provided by any other business in that meals and other services must be paid for in advance and on demand. Most parents and carers understand that they cannot take their child(ren) to McDonald's and expect the provision of food or services without paying, or expect before and after school clubs or the services of a football coach or music teacher to teach their child(ren) free of charge.

However a minority of parents or carers do not pay on time for services provided by the school, putting the school in the position of subsidising these few families with funding that is intended by law to educate all children. This also causes considerable extra work for office staff and embarrassment for all concerned by chasing outstanding money owed to the school.

The Governors at Sharps Copse Primary School take the stance that the best system of approach is a 'NO DEBT' policy. We understand that it may seem a very hard stand as there has previously been a culture of debt tolerance. However, it should become easy to maintain once parents and carers realise our school only offer free school meals to children whose parents qualify for Free School Meal (FSM) entitlement and/or Universal Free School Meals (UFSMs), applicable to children in Years R -2.

To find out if your child is entitled to a free school meal visit www.hants.gov.uk/hc3s and follow 'Free School Meals' to check your eligibility to register, and we'll do the rest for you.

Parents and carers who have not paid for lunches through their child's **SCOPay** account, provided them with a packed lunch or made arrangements for them to go home for lunch, will be contacted by the office.

If a parent or carer genuinely forgets to pay, or has left the packed lunch at home and is unable to return, the school may grant a debt allowance of one meal, and is dependent on whether there are other school debts. However this debt must be paid by the end of the day of receipt or at the latest the next day and future meals must be paid for in advance before any more meals are provided.

If parents and carers make no attempt to clear the debt, provide a packed lunch for their child(ren) or arrange for them to be collected to go home for lunch, the school will send a final letter from the Headteacher warning that legal proceedings may be taken. Once this final letter has been issued, your child won't be able to receive school lunches until the debt has been cleared. There is also a possibility that Children's Services will be informed that these parents or carers are not carrying out their responsibility and duty of care to their child(ren) by not providing food for them at lunchtime.

Parents and carers should be aware that when there is an outstanding debt at school, access to other services eg, Before and After School Activity Clubs will not be permitted until the debt is cleared. Parents and carers should also be aware that fees are expected to be paid in **advance** for their child(ren's) attendance at these clubs as our per **terms and conditions**, and that uncleared debts could lead to their child(ren's) placement being removed. Children's accounts are pre-populated in advance of expected attendance every 4-5 weeks and is dependent on when the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month falls. If a child is absent due to illness or the school has received advanced notice of non-attendance, a credit will be forwarded until they return to school.


