Lunchtime Arrangements

The children will need a **packed lunch** for the trip. To help us be environmentally friendly and responsible with our budget:

- **Free School Meals:** If your child is eligible for a free school meal or requires the school to provide a lunch, please inform the office by **Friday 16th January 2026**.
- **Avoiding Waste:** By letting us know in advance, we can ensure we do not "over-make" lunches, helping us avoid unnecessary food and money wastage.

What to Wear and Bring

As it will be January, please ensure your child is prepared for the day:

- **Uniform:** Normal school uniform is required.
- **Outerwear:** A very **warm coat** is essential for travel and moving between locations.
- **Travel Sickness:** We will be travelling by coach. If your child suffers from travel sickness, please provide them with the necessary tablets/preparations before school and inform the class teacher.

Timings & Travel

- **Start of Day:** Children should arrive at school at the **normal time** for registration.
- **End of Day:** We aim to be back in time for the usual end-of-day pick-up.

- **Traffic Updates:** We are aware of the ongoing delays on the **M27**. Should we be delayed on our return journey, we will keep you updated via our usual communication channels so you know exactly when to expect us.
