As we begin the **summer term**, we're excited to share the fantastic learning experiences your children will be taking part in over the coming weeks.

This term, our curriculum will cover a wide range of engaging and meaningful topics, including:

- **Portugal** – comparing a European country to the UK
- **World War II and the development of Leigh Park** – understanding how the war shaped our local community
- **Healthy Eating** – learning about the importance of a balanced diet
- **Come Dine With Me** – a food-based project where pupils plan, prepare, and serve a three-course meal

The **Come Dine With Me experience** will be our key focus in the final part of the term. During the **first week of July 2025**, each child will have the opportunity to **prepare and serve a three-course meal for an adult at home**, right here in school. It's a lovely opportunity for your child to share their learning with you in a memorable and meaningful way.

All the cooking will be done with the expert support of a **professional teaching chef**, who will visit each class to guide the children through each stage of the process – from planning and preparation, to cooking and serving.

To help cover the cost of this special project – including the **chef's time, ingredients, and any additional equipment** needed – we kindly ask for a **voluntary contribution of £10 per child**. Payments can be made via **ScoPay**, and more details **will be sent out shortly**.

Please note that **if we do not receive at least 75% of the contributions**, we may not be able to go ahead with the experience.

We understand some parents and carers may wish to attend and support this event in person. **Individual class dates for the Come Dine With Me experience will be shared later this week**, in case you'd like to plan ahead or book time off work to enjoy the occasion.
